**Day 1:** Prevention programs of today (delivering what we have)

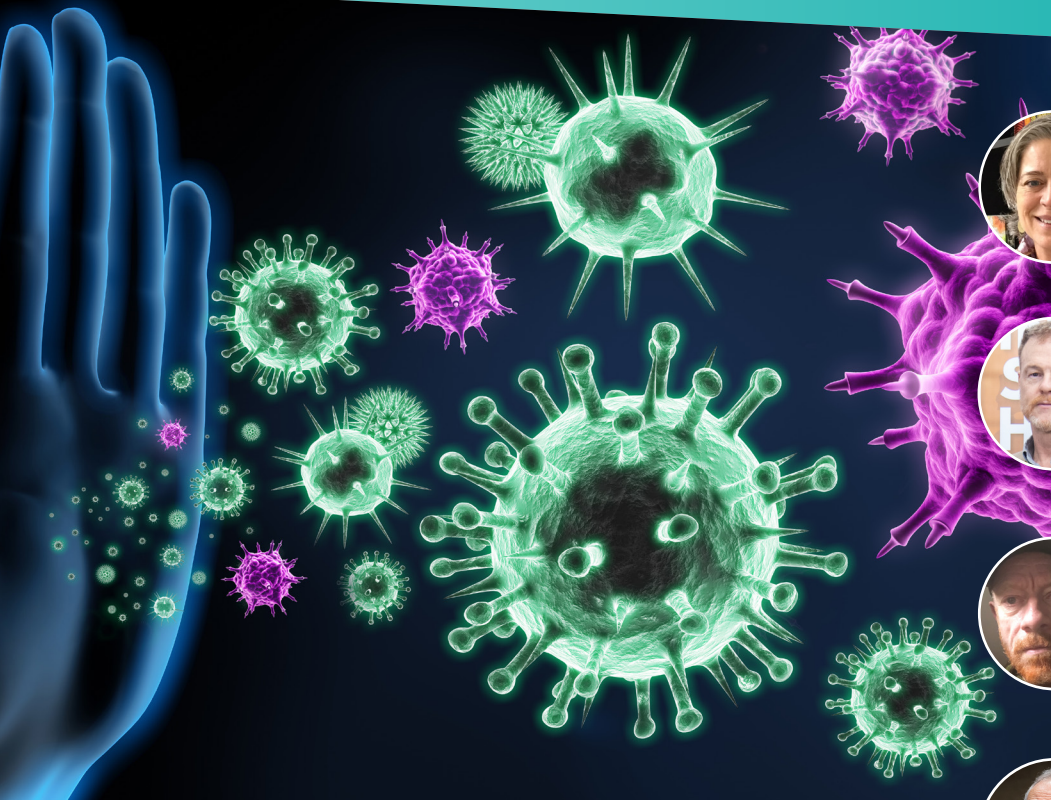
